

Week 7 NFL Preview

Broncos (3-3) @ Saints (2-4)

The Broncos face a Saints team coming off a high-scoring loss. Denver's defense will look to pressure rookie QB Spencer Rattler who is without Olave and Shaheed, while the Saints will need to contain Bo Nix and the Broncos' offense.

Key Matchup: Broncos defense vs. Spencer Rattler.

Prediction: Broncos 27-20 Saints.

Patriots (1-5) @ Jaguars (1-5) - UK Game

Both teams head to London with identical records, but rookie Drake Maye for the Patriots could give them the edge against a struggling Jaguars squad. The Jags are in there second week in England so could have that slight advantage.

Key Matchup: Drake Maye vs. Jaguars secondary.

Prediction: Patriots 24-17 Jaguars.

Seahawks (3-3) @ Falcons (4-2)

Seattle will try to bounce back against a Falcons team that boasts one of the best rushing attacks in the league. The Seahawks' rushing attack must improve after a rough game last week.

Key Matchup: Falcons run game vs. Seahawks front seven.

Prediction: Seahawks 24-27 Falcons.

Titans (1-4) @ Bills (4-2)

Will Levis and the Titans offence will face a tough Bills team led by star Josh Allen who gets a new weapon with Amari Cooper joining. Buffalo's defence could make it a long day for the Titans who have yet to get anything going on offence this season and are turning the ball over too often.

Key Matchup: Bills defence vs. Will Levis.

Prediction: Titans 13-28 Bills.

Bengals (2-4) @ Browns (1-5)

Both teams are desperate for a win. The Bengals will lean on their superstars in Burrow and Chase to get past a tough Browns defence, while the Browns hope DeShaun Watson can finally turn things around after shocking displays in recent weeks and will need to do it with Amari Cooper.

Key Matchup: Joe Burrow vs. Myles Garrett.

Prediction: Bengals 28-19 Browns.

Texans (5-1) @ Packers (4-2)

Two of the NFL's hottest teams collide as Houston's powerful offense meets Jordan Love and the Packers. Both QBs have been on fire, making this a potential shootout. This could go either way and is a must watch game.

Key Matchup: Will Anderson Jr and Danielle Hunter vs. Jordan Love.

Prediction: Texans 30-33 Packers.

Dolphins (2-3) @ Colts (3-3)

The Dolphins need a win to keep pace in their division, but the Colts' could cause problems especially the defensive line. Indianapolis will look to continue their balanced approach on offence, they will be hoping to have Taylor and Richardson back to give them more of a threat.

Key Matchup: Colts defensive line vs. Tyler Huntley.

Prediction: Colts 23-13 Dolphins.

Lions (4-1) @ Vikings (5-0)

<u>A</u> massive NFC North battle between the division's top two teams. The Lions are red-hot but will face their toughest test yet against the undefeated Vikings. This one looks like it will be another fantastic game in what is looking a really good group of fixtures. This could be one of the highest scoring games with both offences coming in hot.

Key Matchup: Lions offence vs. Vikings defence. The Vikings defence is causing issues for so many teams.

Prediction: Lions 27-24 Vikings. This one could go either way, tough one to call.

Eagles (3-2) @ Giants (2-4)

Key Matchup: Eagles pass rush vs. Giants offensive line.

Raiders (2-4) @ Rams (1-4)

The Rams have been inconsistent on offence which has been affected massively with injuries, but they hope Kupp will be ready this week and will welcome Nacua soon after, while the Raiders will need to find a spark after a tough loss and will have to do it without Davante Adams.

Key Matchup: Rams offence vs. Raiders defence.

Prediction: Raiders 16-24 Rams.

Panthers (1-5) @ Commanders (4-2)

The Commanders, led by Jayden Daniels, should have the upper hand against a struggling Panthers team. Carolina's defence will need to find a way to stop the versatile Daniels and find a way to keep pace with a free scoring Commanders team

Key Matchup: Jayden Daniels vs. Panthers defence.

Chiefs (5-0) @ 49ers (3-3)

The undefeated Chiefs take on the 49ers in what promises to be a marquee matchup. Brock Purdy will need to match Patrick Mahomes' offensive firepower for San Francisco to stand a chance. The superbowl repeat from last season promises to be a thrilling encounter and a close match once again.

Key Matchup: Patrick Mahomes vs. 49ers defensive line.

Jets (2-4) @ Steelers (4-2)

The Jets will rely on their Aaron Rodgers and his recent connection with Garrett Wilson as well as a familiar face with Adams joining although a full play package might be a bit too soon. Key Matchup: Steelers rushing attack vs. Jets defence.

Prediction: Jets 17-10 Steelers - if Fields starts I see the Steelers winning this one by 3.

Ravens (4-2) @ Bucs (4-2)

The Ravens will need to limit the explosive Buccaneers offence which has been non stop most of the season, while Lamar Jackson will look to exploit Tampa Bay's defence and seems to have found some really good support with Flowers.
