

Buccaneers @ Falcons

Preview: The Buccaneers (3-1) face a divisional clash with the Falcons (2-2) in Atlanta. Tampa Bay will look to build on their impressive win over the Eagles, while the Falcons aim to extend their hot start, fueled by their balanced offence led by Kirk Cousins and Bijan Robinson.

Key Battle: The Bucs' defensive front vs. Bijan Robinson. Tampa Bay's defence must contain Robinson, who has been a game-changer for Atlanta, to force Ridder into difficult passing situations.

Prediction: Bucs 28-21 Falcons

Jets @ Vikings

Preview: The Jets (2-2) travel to the UK to take on the Vikings (4-0), who are coming off a close win against the Packers. Aaron Rodgers and the Jets offence have been underwhelming, and they'll face a Minnesota team with a high-powered offence led by Justin Jefferson.

Panthers @ Bears

Preview: The Panthers (1-3) look to rebound after a loss to the Bengals, while the Bears (2-2) are gaining momentum behind rookie Caleb Williams. Carolina's offence, led by Andy Dalton, has struggled with consistency, but they'll face a Chicago defence that can be vulnerable to the pass.

Key Battle: Caleb Williams vs. Panthers' pass rush. The Panthers must pressure Williams and force mistakes to slow down Chicago's offence.

Prediction: Panthers 21-24 Bears

Ravens @ Bengals

Preview: The Ravens (2-2) and Bengals (1-3) meet in a crucial AFC North showdown. Lamar Jackson is coming off a dominant win, while Joe Burrow finally got the Bengals their first victory. Both teams have explosive offences, but Baltimore's defence has been playing lights-out football.

Key Battle: Derrick Henry vs. Bengals' linebackers. Cincinnati's defence must limit Henry who is in scintillating form early in the season.

Prediction: Ravens 30-24 Bengals

Dolphins @ Patriots

Preview: The Dolphins (1-3) visit the Patriots (1-3) in an AFC East matchup. Miami's offence will look to bounce back after a poor showing against the Titans, while the Patriots' struggling offence must find answers against a Miami defence that can be vulnerable through the air.

Key Battle: Tyreek Hill vs. Christian Gonzalez A huge matchup that will play a pivotal role for

the winner.

Prediction: Dolphins 15-12 Patriots

Browns @ Commanders

Preview: The Browns (1-3) will try to bounce back from a close loss to the Raiders, facing a surging Commanders team (3-1). Washington's offence, led by rookie Jayden Daniels, has looked explosive, while Cleveland's defence will need to step up and slow down the Commanders' attack.

Key Battle: Myles Garrett vs. Washington's offensive line. Garrett must pressure Daniels and disrupt the Commanders' passing game to give Cleveland's defence a chance.

Prediction: Browns 18-27 Commanders

Colts @ Jaguars

Preview: The Colts (2-2) head to Jacksonville to take on a Jaguars team (0-4) in desperate need of a win. Joe Flacco has filled in admirably for the injured Anthony Richardson, but Trevor Lawrence and the Jaguars' offence have the talent to turn things around at any time. Key Battle: Trevor Lawrence vs. Colts' secondary. Lawrence will need to avoid turnovers and test a Colts defence that has been opportunistic this season.

Prediction Colts 24-18 Jaguars

Bills @ Texans

Preview: The Bills (3-1) face the Texans (3-1) in Houston. Buffalo's offence, led by Josh Allen, has been inconsistent, while C.J. Stroud has been excellent for the Texans in his second year. Houston's defence has also played well, and they'll look to capitalise on any mistakes from Allen.

Key Battle: Josh Allen vs. Texans' defence. Allen must play a clean game against a Texans defence that has been forcing turnovers all season.

Prediction: Bills 28-24 Texans

Raiders @ Broncos

Cardinals @ 49ers

Packers @ Rams
