

Week 9 Review Texans (6-2) @ (2-6) Jets

The Jets at 2-6 are odds on favourite for this game, which on paper is hard to believe but the injuries for the Texans is significant. Nico Collins, Stefon Diggs, Azeez Al-Shaair and Jimmy Ward are huge losses, but even so the Jets look really poor.

Key match-up - Tank Dell Vs Sauce Gardner - Dell has to step up into the wide receiver role otherwise this could be a long night for the Texans.

Prediction - Texans 24-21 Jets

Cowboys (3-4) @ (5-3) Falcons

The Cowboys have been struggling as of late whereas the Falcons have been flying. Kirk Cousin has been finding his receivers with ease and they have been strong defensively. The Cowboys however will be hoping for a fast start and not being out of the game by the third quarter.

Key match-up - Ceedee Lamb Vs AJ Terrell - This is going to be a great battle, the two are playing well, Terrell needs to keep Lamb quiet for as long as possible. Prediction - Cowboys 21-30 Falcons

Dolphins (2-5) @ (6-2) Bills

The Bills are playing some really strong football as they invite the Dolphins into Buffalo. Dolphins looked better with Tua under centre, however they still were not able to get the job done. Allen threw his first interception of the season last week showing how well he has kept the ball safe, the expectation is this will continue but the Dolphins will hope to pressure him. Key match-up - Dolphins pass rush Vs Josh Allen - the Dolphins need to pressure Allen and try to force mistakes which has not been easy this year. Prediction - Dolphins 24-37 Bills

Raiders (2-6) @ (3-5) Bengals

The Raiders and Bengals would have not expected to be this far off the playoffs at this stage of the season, both have really struggled. The Raiders will hope to expose a poor Bengals

defence whereas the Bengals will hope to expose a poor offence. This could be a close game but the Burrow factor plays a big part in this prediction.

Key match-up - Brock Bowers Vs Bengals Linebackers/Nickel. - Bowers is easily the number one target and the Bengals need to stop him.

Prediction - Raiders 18-30 Bengals

Chargers (4-3) @ (2-6) Browns

This game is a tough one to predict, the Chargers are doing well and will hope to keep pushing for a playoff spot, the game two weeks ago would be an easy one to predict. However with the quarterback change for the Browns they looked far better. Winston managed the first 300 passing yards of the season and will want to build on this. Key match-up - Joe Alt Vs Myles Garrett - Alt has held his own against some good defensive lineman this year, he should get reps against one of the very best in the business this week. Prediction - Chargers 28-27 Browns - This is a tough one to predict.

Patriots (2-6) @ (1-6) Titans

A battle for the number one overall pick is here, if Drake Maye was playing the Patriots would be favourite in my opinion. With Maye likely missing this becomes a close game. Levis maybe back, if not Rudolph will take the reins again.

Key match-up - Rhamondre Stevenson Vs Tony Pollard - Whichever running back leads their team best should win this one.

Prediction - Patriots 24-20 Titans

Commanders (6-2) @ (2-6) Giants

The Commanders continue to impress this season thanks to rookie Jayden Daniels. He played through injury last time out. The Commanders maybe the surprise package this year look like the really deal winning tough games. The Giants continue but have found a few nice pieces for the future in Malik Nabers and Tyrone Tracy, but it is unlikely they are able to help enough to win this one.

Key match-up - Jayden Daniels Vs Brian Burns, Azeez Ojulari and Dexter Lawrence. The Giants frontline have to work together to stop Daniels and these three will be key. Prediction - Commanders 34-17 Giants

Key match-up - Bo Nix Vs Ravens Secondary - If Nix can try and get an early lead we have seen a few times the Ravens go away from the run and Derrick Henry.

Prediction - Broncos 24-30 Ravens

The Eagles have been good for long periods this year and all three phases have stepped up for them. Both teams are playing well, the Bears had a tough loss last time out, whereas the Cardinals walk off touchdown gives them hope. Both sides will be wanting to keep momentum to push for a playoff spot. This is likely to be a close battle coming down to which quarterback can lead their side over the line.

Key match-up - Flacco Vs Vikings defensive line - The Vikings will need to stop Flacco finding his receivers.

Prediction - Colts 28-27 Vikings - I can see the Colts nicking this one, the Vikings last two losses key to this.

The Bucs head to Kansas City after a couple of rough weeks losing Chris Godwin and Mike Evans and losing to the Falcons in a divisional match-up.
